It's hard to choose between the citrusy, slightly smoky charred blood orange, tequila and aperol in El Sacrificio or the juniper meets grapefruit and RX vanilla bitters of the Long Way Home. My all-time fave, though, is the rumored to be axed London's Burning, featuring the unusual combo of gin, puréed avocado, jalapeño, and lime. It's a little hot, a little tart, a little creamy and a whole lot of yummy. Try it while it's still on the menu. Regular prices run \$9-13.
